4. Pursuant to Rule 3.220(a)(1)(viii), Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure (1973), whether there has been any electronic surveillance, including wire-tapping, of the premises of the accused, or of conversations to which the accused was a party; and, any documents relating thereto.
