The defendant, through his undersigned legal counsel,
demands that the prosecutor disclose to defense counsel and
permit them to inspect, copy, test and photograph the
following information and material within the State's
possession or control:

1. Pursuant to Rule 3.220(a)(1)(ix), Florida Rules
of Criminal Procedure (1973), whether there has been any
search or seizure and any documents relating thereto.

2. Pursuant to Rule 3.220(a)(1)(vi), Florida Rules
of Criminal Procedure (1973), any tangible papers or objects
which were obtained from or belonged to the accused.

3. Pursuant to Rule 3.220(a)(1)(vii), Florida Rules
of Criminal Procedure (1973), whether the State has any
material information which has been provided by a
confidential informant.

4. Pursuant to Rule 3.220(a)(1)(viii), Florida Rules
of Criminal Procedure (1973), whether there has been any
electronic surveillance, including wire-tapping, of the
premises of the accused, or of conversations to which the
accused was a party; and, any documents relating thereto.
